Executive Session: On motion of Holt and second of R. Williams, Council unanimously voted to enter into executive session.

Close Executive Session: On motion of G. Williams and second of Merritt, Council unanimously voted to end executive session.

Approval-2017/2018 FY Budget: On motion of G. Williams and second of R. Williams, Council voted to approve the 2017-2018 FY budget. Voting in favor were Mayor Phillips, Councilman R. Williams, Councilman Merritt, and Councilman G. Williams. Councilwoman Holt abstained.

Approval-2017 Millage: On motion of G. Williams and second of Merritt, Council unanimously voted to approve the 2017 millage rate at 9.90 which is unchanged from 2016.

Approval-Golf Cart Lease: On motion of Merritt and second of Holt, Council unanimously voted to approve golf cart lease.

Recommendation-Police Chief: On motion of R. Williams and second of Holt, Council unanimously voted to approve recommendation to hire Hollis Smith as the new Chief of Police of Colquitt. Mr. Smith scored the highest during interviews out of eight (8) candidates.

Adjourn: On motion of G. Williams and second of Merritt, Council unanimously voted to adjourn briefly before reconvening for a joint work session with the Miller County Board of Commissioners.

Work Session (w/ Miller County Board of Commissioners)-Recreation Board: On motion of G. Williams and second of Holt, Council unanimously voted to enter into a work session with the Miller County Board of Commissioners to discuss the Recreation Board.
