Persons desiring to register to vote in this election may do so through the close of the day at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, October 5, 2015. In addition, the polling place for all municipal elections will be the same place the county conducts their general elections – the county building located at 2 Mayhaw Drive, Colquitt, Georgia 39837.
