Minutes: On motion of G. Williams and second of Holt, Council unanimously voted to approve the minutes of April 14, 2015.

Colquitt Water Tank-SGRITA: On motion of R. Williams and second of Merritt, Council unanimously voted to approve the placement of SGRITA equipment at the water tower.

On motion of R. Williams and second of Merritt, Council unanimously voted to approve the Department Reports for the month of April 2015.

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On motion of Holt and second of G. Williams, Council unanimously voted to approve Police dept. purchase request to purchase bullet proof vests as the department's current vests are expected to expire by the end of the year. The out of pocket costs for the vests and carriers totals \$4,322.50.

Chief Worsley received a letter from Jimmy Phillips, Technology Director for the Board of Education, requesting help funding the purchase of twelve (12) replacement cameras for law enforcement usage. Eleven (11) will replace existing cameras and one (1) along with wiring, will be added to monitor the football field and Perry Drive entrance. The sheriff was also asked to assist by purchasing the required recording equipment suitable for the cameras. On motion of G. Williams and second of R. Williams, Council unanimously voted to approve this request subject to County approval.
